I am the mother of two young girls who have both had the pleasure of attending RLCDP. My oldest Graduated from the pre-k class of 2013. My youngest daughter currently attends the preschool. Both girls began attending daycare at the age of 4 months, and have grown up under the loving care and instruction of Resurrections wonderful teaching staff.

These teachers have an abundance of patience and experience with young children. By the time my oldest child graduated from preschool she was reading and writing 3 letter words, adding and subtracting numbers up to 10, and identifying patterns and colors. She was very well prepared for kindergarten and was placed with the advanced group of students for study group. I feel she had a head start due to the excellent instruction and preparation provided by the teachers at RLCDP. My youngest daughter (age 3) writes her own name and can also write the name of several of her class mates, she can also name the days of the week and count to 10. Throughout the years both of my girls have brought home various pieces of art displaying hand prints or photos of themselves that they have made into art, they are always so proud of these creations and ask me to hang them up. I adore the personal touches that book mark milestones throughout their young life but I am most grateful to RLCDP for the skills they developed that are the foundation of their educational life.

Our family has been receiving exceptional childcare from Resurrection Lutheran Child Development Program (RLCDP) in Dublin for the past 4.5 years. I have two children (ages 2 and almost 5) in the program. Deciding on infant care and preschool was one of the most challenging decisions I faced as an expecting Mother, and choosing RLCDP was a decision I never second guessed.

When expecting with my oldest child 5 years ago, I toured about 20 daycare centers and home cares and the minute I visited RLCDP I knew it was right.
